The following steps are what it took to get my cowboy guns across the border and back..
2 pistols , shot gun, and rifle..

Step 1 Allow 2 weeks prior before entry

Call above 800 # and ext # and ask for an Authorization to Transport for Non-Resident form. (if you have a fax they can fax it to you , it is faster.) This is the only place you can get the form.

Step 2 Fill out and fax to 604-586-2402 along with an invitation from the club where the match will take place. On your fax cover page offer other phone #'s where they can contact you ..(reminder you can only use the border crossing you write in, and the date.)

Step 3 Go on line and down load form CAFC 909 (3 copies) its on 8 1/2 x 14" paper. You can also open it as a PDF file and fill it out then print..

If more than 3 fire arms go to Step 4

Step 4 Down load form CAFC 910 Non-Resident Fire arms declaration continuation sheet. Can be done on PDF as well..

Step 5 Fill out in triplicate DO NOT SIGN IT .

Step 6 When you receive your ATT form from the Firearms officer it will have your transport # . Your almost ready to go ..

Step 7 Read rules on how to transport as far as locking, etc.

Step 8 Before crossing the Canadian border stop on the US side and go in and ask for a CBP Form 4457 . Fill out description of guns and serial number.

The officer on duty my want to come and check your guns. You sign it as well as the officer. This is your ticket to get your guns back in the States. Don't loose this form, its good for life or till you change guns. No charge.

Step 9 Once at the Canadian border, declare your guns, and that you have your paper work and a ATT permit number. You will have to go inside and speak with an officer.

Take your paper work in with you.. If no one is in line it take about 10 minutes. At this time you sign form 909 . Pay \$25.00 Canadian Funds.(I think they take bank cards as well) (its good for 60 days)

Step 10 Upon return to US have your CBP form 4457 and declare your firearms to the CBP officer.
