

Universal Firearms Handling Rules

- 1. All firearms are always loaded! They must be handled with due care and caution.
2. Keep your finger off of the trigger until your sights are on the target.
3. Be aware of where your muzzle is pointed at all times, and never point your gun at anything you are not willing to shoot.
4. Be sure of YOUR TARGET, and what is behind and beyond your target.

- 1. The Custer Sportsmen's Club Chief Range Officer (CRO) & Board Of Directors (B.O.D.) have TOTAL authority over the handling and discharge of firearms, and the conduct of all persons on the premises. Failure to abide by these rules, and by any SAFETY-related commands issued by the CRO or B.O.D. members of the Custer Sportsmen's Club will result in your being escorted from the premises without any refund of fees.
2. Eye and Ear Protection is required for shooters and spectators while on the firing line.
3. Shooting hours on out door ranges are from 9am-9pm or dusk which ever comes first.
4. CSC is a members only club, you must be a member or a guest of a member who is present to shoot here.
5. Sign in immediately upon entering range and pay range fee's, Members \$2.00 and Guest \$ 6.00
6. To use your card key pass card in front of sensor when it beeps simply push open the gate (do not turn the handle). DO NOT Prop open the access gate.
7. Absolutely no handling of firearms allowed during a cease fire when individuals are down range. During a cease fire all firearms must be in a safe condition, actions open, magazines out muzzle pointed at the berm or rifles may be in rifle racks.
8. You must coordinate with other shooters on the same firing line to call a cease fire prior to stepping beyond the front edge of the shooting line. If a cease fire is called you must immediately end shooting, unload your weapon and place your firearm with the action open and the magazine out on the firing line table or in a rack.
9. It is your responsibility to ensure that every round fired impacts the berm. Deliberately or repeatedly firing so that your bullets do not impact the backstop will result in your ejection from the premises.
10. Use only paper targets attached to the plywood target boards. (do not shoot target board supports, do not put targets at any other position targets must be on target boards only)
11. It is your responsibility to clear up after you are done shooting. Remove trash, targets, and brass.
12. Only persons over 18 years of age may use the range without immediate supervision of a responsible adult acting with parental consent. All Handgun users must be 21 years of age or older, or under the immediate supervision of a responsible adult with parental consent.
13. No alcohol or illegal substances allowed.
14. CSC is a cold range. Firearms are to be unloaded and in a safe condition while being carried to and from vehicles. Pistols are not to be carried loaded in holsters (except LE or by approval of CSC Range Master). Drawing from the holster is prohibited with the exception of approved IPSC competitors, Cowboy Action competitors, and Law Enforcement personnel.
15. Action shooting ranges on back part of range are only to be utilized by safety approved competitors (i.e. IPSC, Cowboy Action, Bowling Pin, Tact. Rifle, Speed Steel, Bianchi, & Law Enforcement) In order to be approved for this part of the facility you must be involved with one of these disciplines and undergo an additional safety class given by the Discipline Chairs. In addition you must have a range fee card on file for use of this section of the Range.
16. The indoor range is not open to general access, it is reserved for competition group activities. Approval to use the indoor range must be granted by one of the discipline chairmen who use this range, or the Range Master.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURIES AND ACCIDENTS:

I UNDERSTAND THAT FIREARMS ARE POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS OBJECTS THAT CAN CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH IF MISUSED. I AGREE THAT I WILL ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY AND ALL INJURIES, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES WHICH MIGHT OCCUR TO ME, AND/OR GUEST, WHILE ON THE PREMISES OF THE CUSTER SPORTSMEN'S CLUB, AND TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW I AGREE TO RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS CUSTER SPORTSMEN'S CLUB, ITS MEMBERS, BOARD OF DIRECTORS, MEMBERS, AND AGENTS FROM ANY LIABILITY WHATSOEVER FOR INJURIES, LOSSES OR DAMAGES; I AGREE THAT I ACCEPT TOTAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR MY ACTIONS, AND I WILL INDEMNIFY AND HOLD CUSTER SPORTSMEN'S CLUB HARMLESS, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, FROM COSTS (INCLUDING LEGAL FEES), INJURIES, DAMAGES LOSSES, OR LIABILITY TO THIRD PARTIES FOR CLAIMS ASSERTED AGAINST CUSTER SPORTSMEN'S CLUB ARISING FROM MY CONDUCT, AND/OR THE CONDUCT OF MY FAMILY AND AND/OR GUESTS, WHILE ON THE PREMISES OF CUSTER SPORTSMEN'S CLUB. I FURTHER CERTIFY THAT I AM NOT PROHIBITED UNDER ANY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW FROM POSSESSING A FIREARM.
