CSC's own youth pistol team ("Team Gotta") shot a "perfect season" in 2015, winning their State, Regional, and National Championships in the Scholastic Pistol Program. In addition to winning the high school title, the team out-shot Texas A&M university to set the national all-ages speed record for rimfire (twice), then went on to set the all-ages centerfire team record -- breaking the record previously held by the US Military Academy at West Point. Team Captain Jordon Castro and shooter Max Rosser both earned \$1,000 scholarships, and Castro was recently offered a co-op sponsorship contract

from SIG SAUER. Coach Robin Taylor asks me to stress that their success was a team effort, relying in large measure on assistant coaches Tony Castro, James Coffey, Gerald Rutgers, and a squad of supportive parents standing alongside their young athletes. "Team Gotta has really grown," he says.

Our Junior Rifle program is the most impressive in the state of Washington. Some of our rifle team members have achieved state, regional, national, and international recognition for their rifle marksmanship proficiencies. Presently, the Custer Sportsmen Club will have nine juniors competing in high power team matches, during the 2016 season
