

CUSTER SPORTSMENS CLUB MATCH SET UP POLICY

Custer Sportsmen's Club is starting a written policy to address the real and/or potential conflict between match set up and individual back range use due to a number of minor problems. We want to have an understanding before a larger problem arises.

Monday thru Friday until 6PM back range bays 6 and 9 are rented to outside Law Enforcement Agencies for training. They have absolute priority in these bays unless otherwise negotiated by the CSC Board of directors or their representative.

Junior teams have been given bay 7 and 8 for evening training on Tuesday and Thursday. See the Club Calendar for specifics.

Occasionally other bays, usually 4 and sometimes 8 will be rented to law enforcement agencies for training. Usually but not always this will be a day time rental. Check with the Range Officer and Club Calendar for specifics.

Large Matches may have reserved and/or closed the back range for days outside of the normal weekend matches. This closure will have Board of Director Approval.

Bay set up and match running matches:

Friday, Saturday and Sunday back bays match directors will have priority for bay usage either for set up or the match itself.

Monday thru Thursday individuals have priority for bay usage outside of the above stated exceptions. If you need to set up early asking may go a long way.

Once a bay is set up, it will be roped off saying match set up. Individuals may still use the bay and the set up with the restrictions that they must not change or alter the lay out of the bay. Repainting of the steel is desired please. If a bay is set up for a major event it will mean the bay cannot be used at all.

Shooters, if you are in a bay and the setup people come in, it will most often be interesting and fun for you to ask to help set up. Shooters are friendly and often very interested in talking about their discipline.

Match set up folks, if you get to a bay you want to set up that is occupied, ask the person if they would like to help and also let them know that you will only be there for a short time and they can use the bay after you are finished as long as they do not alter it.

Bay Usage:

Set a time limit of 4 hours on any Back- Range practice or casual training for that day. Anything over 4 hours requires a bay rental. Bay rentals cannot interfere with match or match set up without CEO and Match director approval.
