



Custer Sportsmen's Club Guest Policy

1. Front range guests are non-members, back range guests are anyone who does not have a back-range pass.
2. Guests must be under members direct supervision at all times.
3. No more than 2 guests at a time unless approved by 2 members of the executive board. Groups larger than 4, executive board members should consider consultation with Secretary of Safety before granting approval.
4. Written synopsis of what you plan to do will help speed the approval.
5. Groups larger than 4 should consider hiring a CSC approved instructor and / or additional CSC Range Officers qualified individuals to assist in the training as safety personnel.
6. No more than one individual will be handling a gun at a time. The on-duty Range Officer can approve multiple guest handling guns at the same time on the front line only. All back-range guests will be limited to one individual at a time handling guns.
7. Guests of CSC approved Range Officers can draw from the holster and move and shoot, guest of non-CSC approved Range Officers cannot draw from the holster or move and shoot.
8. CSC approved Range Officers are those that have taken the CSC Range Officer class, and those that have completed the USPSA Range Officer certification.
9. All guests must sign liability release provided by CSC.
10. All guests will pay the \$6 guest fee. Club members who are not back range pass holders will pay \$3 range fees when a guest of a back range pass holder unless they have a range pass.
11. Failure to abide by these rules may result in loss of guest privileges and / or range access.
