

# **I-1639 Training Class**

## **“Self Defense, the Law, and You!”**

This class meets the training requirements of I-1639 (RCW 9.41.090) to purchase an “Assault Rifle”, e.g. any semi-automatic rifle. Presentation of valid photo identification is required in order to obtain an I-1639 training certificate.

The class is presented by Mike and Diana Hassebrock of Whatcom Firearms Training LLC. In the class we will discuss:

1. Various types of self-defense tools, other than firearms, and their limitations in a self-defense situation.
2. Washington State laws (RCW) on defense of self, others, and property
3. Washington laws (RCW) on concealed carry, open carry, and both Federal and State prohibited places to carry
4. The legal definition of a “Reasonable Man” will be explained and how it is used in court. What constitutes “reasonable actions” will be covered in great detail.
5. The economics of using lawful force.
6. What to expect in the aftermath of a self-defense encounter including suggestions on how to interact with police.
7. The unanticipated costs of using lawful force at home.
8. Basic firearms safety rules, as required by I-1639
9. Safe storage, as required by I-1639
10. Children and firearms, as required by I-1639
11. Firearms and suicide prevention, as required by I-1639

This class does not include live fire, or instruction on individual firearms.

You will receive a certificate of compliance with the training requirements of I-1639 in order purchase an “Assault Rifle”.

The cost of the class is:

\$150 per person

\$275 per couple and \$125 for each additional immediate family member

\$100 for minors 17 and under,

This class will also qualify you to apply for an Arizona non-resident concealed carry license. If you wish to exercise this option, the Arizona training certificates and required fingerprinting are an extra \$20 per person. Combined with your Washington CPL, the Arizona non-resident CPL allows you to currently carry in 35 states. The Utah CPL currently is only 34 states. Even if you have the Utah CPL, I would encourage you to get the Arizona CPL too. Laws and relationships between the various states constantly change. Having more than one type of permit could help to legally cover you if/when concealed carry laws change.
